had of Cattle & fifteen Horses  
had to haul out fodder every  
day about four shocks that  
made it a rough job  
we received a letter dated December  
21 - from Walter & Zach they were

got it untill Saturday your Mas-  
s is very proud of it & said that  
she considered it the best Christmas  
present that she had received  
this Christmas & she hoped to  
be able to repay you some day  
Zach said in his letter that  
Walter had gone in partnership  
with Mr. Abbot Master to Comm-  
ence New years day. he is said to  
be the best Mr. in the County  
he quit the Practice several years ago  
& run a Merchant Mill in Ashland  
made 200-Hundred bbl of flour  
per day he got his Mill burnt  
this winter & went back to  
his profession again he is a  
Brother to the one he was with
